The participants represented a number of countries and organizations (94 participants, 30 countries). The highlight of the meeting was the field trip on the 2nd day to Murere district. The participants had the chance to appreciate the work of the community health workers. Overall, the feedback for the meeting was "very good" and "good".

In particular, the representation (NMCPs) from many African malaria affected countries was highlighted several times as an ideal way to learn from each other experiences. 


Table 1 Evaluation of presentations and discussions
