## JOINT RBM/CARN MISSION TO EQUATORIAL GUINEA

CARN coordinator and Dr Carole Eboumbou of the CARN coordination committee carried out a mission to Malabo. During this mission, they participated at the Bioko Island Malaria Vaccine Initiative and had working sessions with the NMCP, WHO and MCDI. Discussions were on their Malaria Program Review, their road map, the level of reduction of malaria morbidity and mortality on the island of Bioko and prevailing situation on the mainland (two worlds apart). The main recommendation from the various meetings was that the Malaria Program Review should be conducted as soon as possible and the country should then finalise the road map based on solid gaps analysis .
